

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VEHICLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

Vehicle Power of Attorney

Probably the transaction that missionaries most often encounter is the purchase or sale of a motor vehicle. This form is provided because many times these transactions are not completed before leaving for their field of service, or a document has been incorrectly executed after a missionary leaves.

Executing this document gives the person named the ability to correct or sign any needed document in the place of the missionary that is not unavailable. Remember again, it is important to have this document notarized. A second very important point is that the description and vehicle identification number must match perfectly with that on the title and on the vehicle.
